

Chairperson Report 2025 - NZMOA

The year has been a challenging one. The sector has been locked in the constraints of the economic times, and which influences daily decision making and wellbeing. Our customers are doing it tough and therefore so are all our members. Flat levels of activity extend to negative perceptions and performance which ultimately impact investment decisions which in turn cycle back to constrained thinking and conservative business planning.

There are a range of economic indicators and sector statistics that illustrate the current state of play, but I do not wish to dwell on these - as there is always light! A number of us have been through these cycles and know that the sector is very responsive to improving sentiment from economic uplift as a result of lower interest rates, and growing confidence.

On the brighter side we had an improved summer season and by all accounts the fishing was great too!

When times are tough the tough get going...and that has been the mantra of your Executive over the past 12 months. There has been a huge effort going into significant and foundational work that will deliver long-term value to members.

- Skills based training and development working with the membership and MAST to develop industry-based qualifications for our people.
- Re-developed NZMOA website with updated material resources
- Submissions to the Biosecurity Act review
- Submissions to the RMA Reform legislation and processes
- Antifoul paint performance
- Clean Hull Programs and Marine Biosecurity
- Preparation for the next Health of the Marina/ Boatyard sector survey

- · Refreshing the Clean Marinas Program
- Training grant program

I still see many marinas and boatyards evolving operationally with a number advancing in areas of environmental quality management, security and access, training and professional development, database systems implementations and a continued focus on customer service delivery.

While down on prior years, investment continued to be made with Whangārei pushing ahead with its Okara Marina development and refurbishment programs are being delivered at several other sites around New Zealand. New marina developments are in planning stages in the Auckland and Northland areas. Acquisitions of new land-based haul out equipment continued with several new investments made throughout the country.

The regional development investment that has flowed out of the last two governments via MBIE and the PGF has gone, and the sector will face investment decisions without this support of recent times. The stimulus will need to come from our customers and growth in boating activity generally. I am hopeful that private and local government investment will continue to support growth and the opportunities the sector brings to the lives of those in our communities.

NZMOA actively supports its member aspirations by providing support and advice. The two Open Forum events held in Auckland in May had great attendance, which reflected positively on the value members derived from these events in the past. I certainly appreciated the involvement of your executive in making these a success. The greatest benefit from these events is the sharing of the tangible experiences of those who operate day to day in our marinas and boatyards.

The Executive have been busy addressing number of issues in the regulatory space. There is work being done across National Environmental Standards, Clean Hulls and Biosecurity, Craft Risk Management Standards, Regional Pest Management Pathway Plans, and Regional Plan reviews.

I will also raise awareness around the future of demand and where we see this now and going to. We have been blessed with the fact that boating in New Zealand is our biggest recreational pursuit, however there are some threats to this being sustained into the future. For our new generation of boaties, time availability and the affordability of boating need careful consideration. Maintaining and growing demand in our sector needs the attention of us all.

As you can see there remains more work for your Executive to do on your behalf. I want to thank the team for their hard work over the past year which has included continued work on our communications strategy and work around being more connected and accessible to members. A special thank you to our hard-working administrative team of Phil Wardale and Zoe Hawkins.

I am pleased with the continued growth of our membership both full and Associate members. We stand at record numbers and once again I am pleased to report a healthy financial position. We are well placed to fund the body of work above and deliver continued value to the membership.

Thank you all for your support especially our Associate memberships and family of sponsors.

The future remains bright for our sector. We cannot, however, ignore the challenges emerging from various points around the compass.

The currently regulatory environment is being reviewed, and I see very positive change for our sector here. We must remain engaged in the many and varied consultation opportunities. Climate and Sustainability will forever be more integrated in our decision making. We must look forward with confidence and embrace challenges as we have in recent years.

I am immensely proud of the cohesion of our Association and the professional advancement of our members and their businesses.



ADVOCACY

Navigating the cycles of change

Successive governments
work to balance the
requirements of a healthy
economy with those of a
healthy environment and
the result can be, in these
changing times, uncertainty
for infrastructure providers.

Our industry, with its role in economic development and employment, and a duty of care to the natural environment, must have a voice in the processes that feed into crown decisions.


Therefore NZMOA has commissioned a body of work from legal specialists Gascoigne Wicks to review the Government's National Direction Reform Consultation packages encompassing a new National Policy Statements for Infrastructure, Natural Hazards, Coastal Policy, Freshwater Management and Resource Management.

In October 2024 we submitted on the Marine and Coastal Area (Tukatau Moana) (Customary Marine Title) Amendment Bill, recognising the importance of working with tangata whenua, and representing our concerns relating to the ability to develop infrastructure in the future. In early 2025 we also provided feedback on the proposed amendments to the Biosecurity Act, where we generally supported the principles of the amendments but opposed some of the proposals in the interests of our industry and our customers.

NZMOA's goal is to assist the industry in continuing to contribute to the economy, provide vital infrastructure, and create hubs of recreation and employment, all while respecting environmental values.

Dixon Stainless: Still on the up!

In Warkworth, just north of Auckland, Dixon Stainless is forging ahead, even amid economic headwinds.

Founded on legacy products like stainless boarding ladders, handrails and gas-hob toasters originally designed by Neil Dixon, the company was acquired in 2006 by local entrepreneurs Jane Warren and Andrew Wilkes.

Since then, they have evolved Dixon into a precision fabrication hub. It serves not only its traditional marine based customer base with products like custom stanchions, rod holders and ladders, it has expanded into playground installations, components for rockets, trains, food-service fittings, art installations and balustrades for schools and housing —all fabricated locally to exacting standards and in a range of materials including stainless steels, aluminium, titanium, engineering plastics, FRP and carbon fibre.

Customers include many New Zealand marinas, Kiwirail, Sealegs, Dickey Boats, Eke Panuku Development Auckland, Rocket Lab, Fisher & Paykel and clients in Australia, the UK, Europe and the USA.

"Dixon has stayed agile by investing in in-house fabrication capabilities," Andrew says. "Installing multiple water-jet cutting machines and expanding CNC, presswork, tube bending and welding lines has let us control lead times, reduce reliance on outsourced supply, and take on custom and production-run orders across industries."

"We have a lean team of 17 including skilled tradesfolk, NZ qualified mechanical design engineers and apprentices which means we can be flexible in handling bespoke projects without losing scale."

Looking forward, Dixon Stainless remains strongly positioned:
